We are delighted to offer the first teas ever grown in Scotland. The founders of the Wee Tea company have been raising tea plants at the Dalreoch Estate near Pitlochry since 2011, battling challenging weather in this verdant 'field of the king' to produce exceptional teas which have been served in Buckingham Palace and Balmoral.

Royal Scottish

This is a malty and rich yet aromatic with a wonderfully rounded taste.

Famous Scot

A light, bright and refreshing with a full curranty character. A balanced refreshing cup.

Earl Grey

A tea delicately scented with the oil of Bergamot, a citrus fruit akin to lime. A very refreshing brew with a hint of sharpness drunk with either milk or lemon.

Scottish Cherry Green

The delicate flavour of green tea balance well with subtle flavour of Japanese cherry.

Ecclefechan Oolong

The large black twisted leaves of this fine semi-fermented Oolong provide a character which is light, as if gently scented by fruit blossom

Garrocher

The orthodox leaf gives a bright curranty cup with a crisp astringency that is perfect foil for a slice of lemon.

Dalreoch Smoked

This large leaf black tea has a powerful tarry aroma and a very distinctive smoky taste. There is no grey area with this tea, you either love it or loathe it.

Dalreoch Silver Needles

Only the youngest and finest leaves are plucked and gently dried to produce this light and delicate tea. The character is nutty and best enjoyed without milk.
